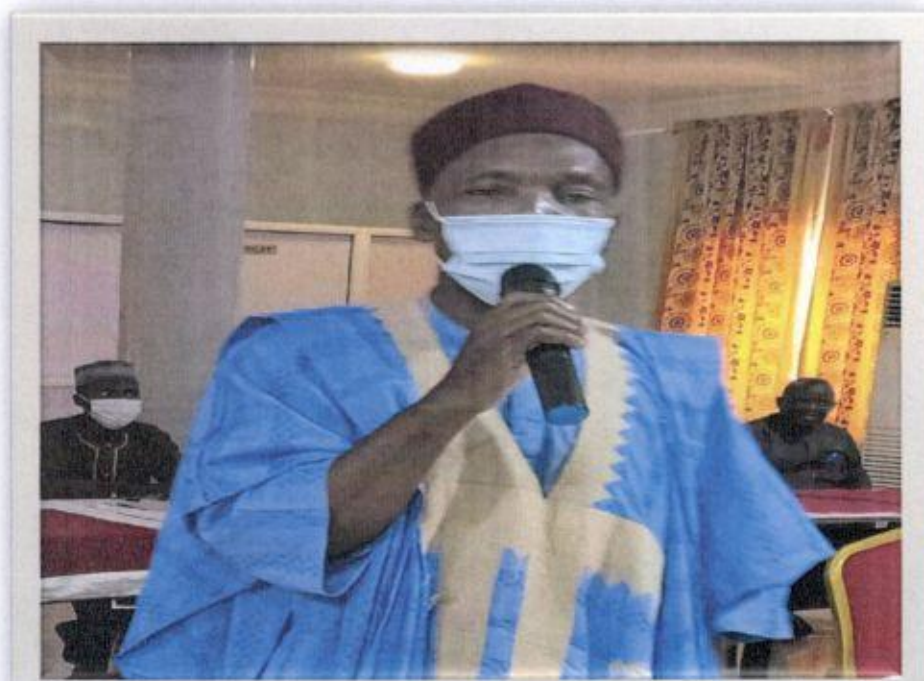

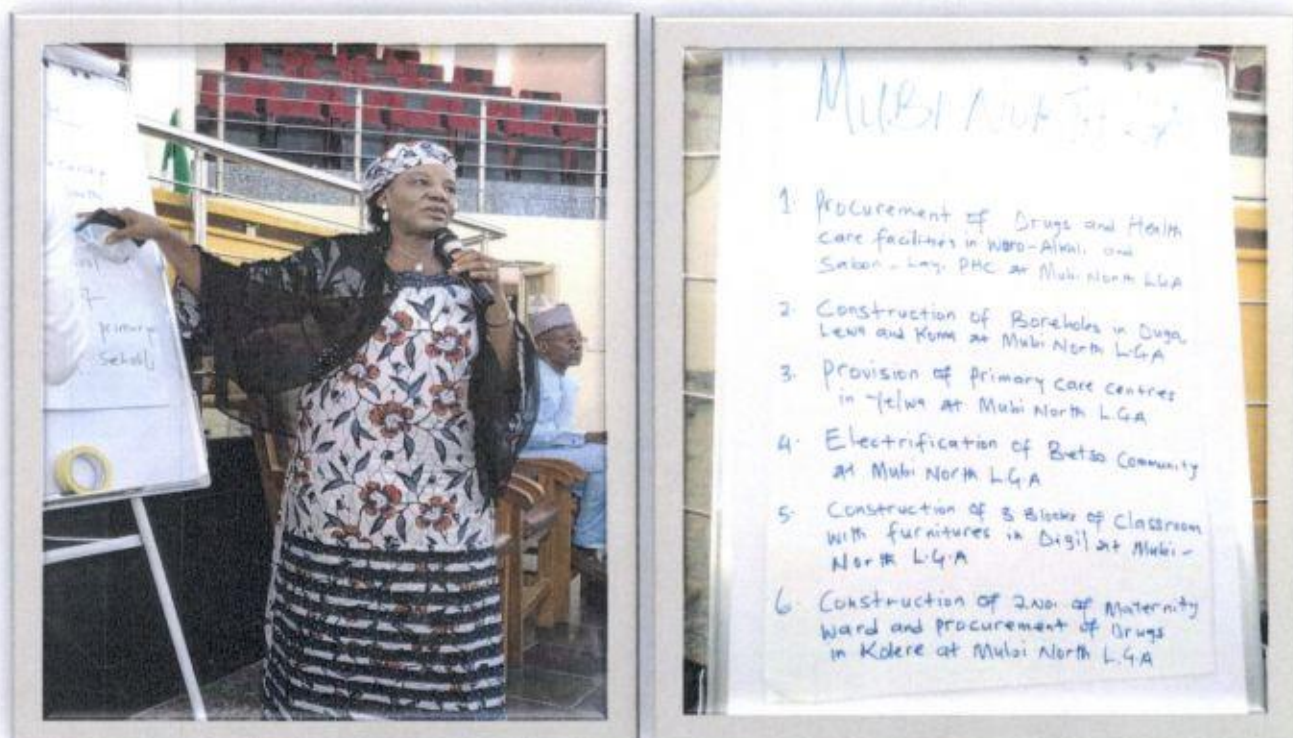

14. Construction of internal road network at wuro Jabbe
15. Construction of Classroom in Goron and Tambo
16. Rural Electrification of Goron and Tambo
17. Construction of road network in lakare and bayan tasha sani Yolde pate
18. Construction of industrial borehole in Yola South LGA among other.




Cross section of participant from Fofure, Girei, Yola North, Yola South, LGAs

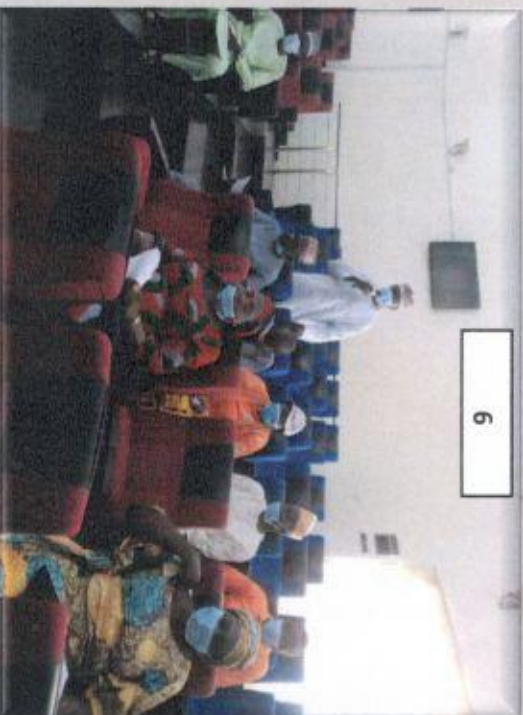
