respect of Medical Refunds, as relevant documents/receipts were not attached to the payment A total of N2,878,275.00 stands as improperly vouched payments to sundry staff of the Ministry in December, 2012, the observation was communicated to the Honourable Commissioner for Ministry of vouchers to authenticate the genuineness of the expenditures. In my Inspection Report dated  $3^{\rm rd}$ Health requesting him to explain or recover the amount paid to each staff and furnish me with the recovery particulars. His reply was yet to be received in my Office.
