STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

The following are the significant accounting policies which have been adopted by the State Government, as stated by the Accountant General

1. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The financial statements are prepared under the historical basis of accounting.

- 2. PRESENTATION OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT
 Detail of General and specific Funds are shown by way of notes in the financial statements of the state Government.
- 3. INVESTMENTS:
 Investments shares are held under the Ministry of Finance Incorporated (MOFI) and are stated at cost.
- 4. STATUTORY ALLOCATION:
 Statutory allocation is made up of revenue collected on a monthly basis which represents the State's share of the Federation account. The state's share in Federation account, excess crude receipts etc are all included in the gross statutory allocation in the Financial Statements. Statutory allocations are recognized in the financial statements when received.
- RECURRENT REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE:

 Recurrent revenue are revenue generated by the State from taxes, fees, fines sales, earnings, rents on government property, income from investments and other incidental revenue. They are recognized in the financial statements when received. Recurrent expenditures are expenditure on personnel, pension and gratuities, salaries of statutory office holders, other overheads and public charges. They are recognized in the financial statements of the state when payments are made.
- 6. CAPITAL COST:
 Capital costs are recognized in their year of occurrence only.
- 7. FOREIGN CURRENCY:
 Transactions in foreign currencies are converted into Naira at the prevailing rates of exchange as at 31st December, 2015.
- 8. ASSETS AND LIABILITIES:
 Assets are stated at their book values while liabilities are recognized in full.





RESPONSIBILITY FOR FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

These Financial Statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the finance (Control and Management) Act Cap 144 LFN 1990. The Financial Statements comply with Generally Accepted Accounting Practice (GAAP).

To fulfil accounting and reporting responsibilities, the Accountant-General is responsible for establishment and maintaining an adequate system of internal controls designated to provide reasonable assurance that the transactions recorded are within statutory authority and property recorded the use of all public financial resources by the Government. Responsibility for the integrity and objectivity of the Financial Statements rests entirely with the Government; and to the best of my knowledge, the system of internal control has been operated adequately throughout the reporting period. Therefore, these Financial Statements reflect the financial position of Government as at 31st December 2015 and its operations for the year ended on that date.

I accept responsibility for the integrity of these Financial Statements, the Information they contain and their compliance with the Finance (Control and Management) Act Cap 144 LFN 1990.

In my opinion, these Financial Statements fairly reflect the financial position of the Imo State Government as at 31st December, 2015 and its operations for the year ended on that date.
